PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Dear Fellow Rotarians,

Greetings!

Today is our 13th regular meeting after a long weekend. I hope everyone enjoyed their vacation. It is also our first meeting for the month of November, Rotary Foundation Month. The Foundation was created during the 1917 convention, outgoing RI President Arch C. Klumph proposed to set up an endowment “for the purpose of doing good in the world.” In 1928, it was renamed The Rotary Foundation, and it became a distinct entity within Rotary International. When Rotary founder Paul Harris died in 1947, contributions began pouring in to Rotary International, and the Paul Harris Memorial Fund was created to build the Foundation.

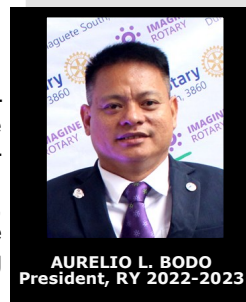
The Rotary Foundation relies on contributions from Rotarians and friends of Rotary around the world, and it recognises their giving at different levels. The Paul Harris Fellow recognition acknowledges individuals who contribute, or who have contributions made in their name, of US\$1,000. By 2006 over one million people had been recognised as Paul Harris Fellows.

The Paul Harris Fellow is named after the founder of Rotary, and it was established in 1957 to show appreciation for and encourage substantial contributions to the Rotary Foundation. Individuals who make a commitment to contribute US\$1,000 every year are recognised as Paul Harris Society members, and once their giving reaches US\$10,000 they are recognised as a major donor.

In District 3860, there is a yearly Recognition night. And for this year it will be held on November 18, 2022, 6:00 PM at the Cebu Country Club, Cebu City. This year's Theme is “IMAGINE Doing Good in the World”. Registration Fee is Php 2,000.00, Attire: Coat and Tie for Men and Cocktail Dress for Ladies. See you there.

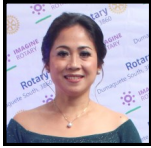

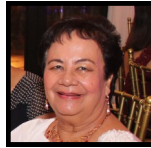
